Pre-Screening at Home

Parents are required to pre-screen students for COVID symptoms before sending them to school. ***If your student exhibits ANY of the following symptoms, keep them home and call the school to report their absence by 9:00 a.m. The nurse will make a follow up call to you.***



- Fever of 100.4° F or greater/chills
- Cough (especially ***new onset, uncontrolled***)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or nausea
- Muscle or body aches or fatigue
- Headache (***new onset of severe headache, especially with fever***)
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
